Process Improvement and Problem Solving

Team Consulting has its origins with NASA and many business consulting firms. It is a method for problem solving that includes active participation from everyone present for the process.

Guidelines

- 1. Responsibility: the owner of the goal or problem is responsible for corrective action plan and solution
- 2. Time Management: assign a timekeeper and time limit; stay on track. Typically a team consulting session should last 10 to 15 minutes.
- 3. Ground Rules:
 - A. Focus on the problem, not the person
 - B. Be open to new ideas and listen
 - C. Balance participation to utilize the group's resources
 - D. Don't be defensive, don't reject ideas
- 4. Actions:
 - A. Owner (2 minutes)
 - 1. State the problem
 - 2. Define the goal
 - 3. State the facts/background
 - 4. Questions from the team
 - 5. State "how to / how do we" question
 - B. Team (5-10 minutes)
 - 1. Give possible solutions (with clear action steps) in the form of statements
 - 2. Write down suggestions
 - C. Owner (2-3 minutes)
 - 1. Commit to a series of action steps
 - 2. Summarize
 - 3. Select action steps and write them down
